## KISA School Re-entry Survey

- The KISA School Re-Entry survey was developed in partnership with the Kent Intermediate Superintendents' Association (KISA) - Future Learning Committee and Jeff Gartner and Associates.
- The survey has multiple purposes:
- Identify safety concerns in resuming school in the fall.
- Understand parents' perception of "distance" learning during the state-mandated school closure of Spring 2020.
- Guide decisions around health and safety, instruction and students' overall well-being.


## Notes on the analysis

- The survey had over 30,000 respondents - one of the largest COVID-19-related school surveys statewide.
- Analysis shared is a stratified random sample of 800 respondents - representative of the demographic makeup of our region.
- Online survey was available between May 29 and June 10 ${ }^{\text {th }}$, with options for both English and Spanish.
- Paper copies and QR codes were available at food distribution sites to reach families without internet access.
- Data is disaggregated by respondent groups (e.g. race/ethnicity, special education, income, etc.) - so that we may better understand and meet the needs of every child.
- Analysis shared here is countywide, however each of the 20 local school districts will have access to their own results.
